UGC also offers a two-credit course titled "**Community Engagement and Social Responsibility**" on the SWAYAM platform ([https://onlinecourses.swayam2.ac.in/ugc24\\_ge05/preview](https://onlinecourses.swayam2.ac.in/ugc24_ge05/preview)).

Several higher education institutions (HEIs) have already joined UBA, contributing to the development of rural India. By collaborating with local authorities, faculty, and students, these institutions are expected to adapt existing technologies and innovate new solutions to address local needs, thereby enhancing the effectiveness of government schemes. Further, already registered institutions are requested to submit their proposals under UGCs Subject Expert Group (SEG)-Curriculum Reforms and Educational Institutions and Social Responsibility as detailed in **Annexure I** through the UBA Proposal Submission Portal (<https://unnatbharatabhiyan.gov.in/>) for the UBA Subject Expert Groups (SEGs), open until the 30th October 2024.

## Annexure I

### UBA Subject Expert Groups (SEGs) and Proposal Categories

Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) may submit their proposals under the following Subject Expert Group (SEG) in any of the proposal categories as mentioned below:

**I. Curriculum Reforms and Educational Institutions' Social Responsibility**

**II. Proposal Categories**

**1. Technology Development:**

- Proposals should involve technological interventions that are fully developed and ready for dissemination in rural areas. These solutions must address real needs, identified through baseline surveys, and should already be tested in the field. The fund cap for this category is ₹1,00,000.
- *Key Points:*
  - The technology should be sustainable, scalable, and innovative.
  - Solutions must not be restricted to prototypes or lab-based projects; field implementation is necessary.
  - PIs must ensure long-term sustainability beyond project completion.

**2. Technology Customization:**

- This category involves modifying existing technologies available in the market to better suit the specific geographical and socio-economic needs of rural populations. Proposals should outline clear objectives and deliverables with time-bound results. The fund cap for this category is ₹2,50,000.
- *Key Points:*
  - Customization must meet specific needs of rural communities.
  - Proposals should be outcome-oriented with defined timelines.
  - PIs should ensure that projects are sustainable after the funded period.

**Note:** Proposals for long-term research, fellowships, Ph.D. programs, setting up laboratories/centers, exhibitions, workshops, or capital/construction costs will not be

funded under UBA. The focus is strictly on field-based technical interventions in UBA-connected villages.
